These work demons examine every amendment in terms of frame to the law formed and the enforcement of it all. We saw how these documents were created from start to finish and those involved in the process. We then see what is created as a result of this document and its consequences. Fifty-five delegates from twelve states met in Philadelphia in 1787 and wrote it defining the framework for the American government and the rights of its citizens. Delegates want to insure that their new country preserve the freedoms they have just fought the war to get. Which of the following is NOT the federal government's branch?
